Hard copy photographs

Send as wide a range of images as possible, including both exterior and interior shots where appropriate. Also send images at a variety of scales, that is, ranging from overall shots of the project to close-ups of details. Original photographs are not required at this time. *Prints of color photos are required.*

Hard copy floor plans, site plans, and other drawings

Include images of the project's floor and site plans. Include other drawings pertinent to your project, including sketches, elevations, and sections, as well as drawings of details.

Hard copy written description of the project

This information can come in any form you choose. A form is provided below for supplying the basic information. You may also wish to include further information that you feel is interesting or pertinent.

NOTE: If you want your materials returned, you must include a self-addressed stamped envelope. Please allow the TA staff at least six months to consider your project. If your project is selected for publication, the staff will contact you to request additional materials. Contact any member of the TA staff at (512) 478-7386 if you have questions.
